

Some Facts:



- Right to manual processing



Fines of up to 20 million € or 4% of annual global turnover , whichever is the greatest	
Turnover is total (GROUP) SALES	
Example	100 million € = 4 million €

Reputational damage and/or class-actions

Fine of 4% or 20M€

Fine of 2% or 10M€
