




The Silent Disruption

In Germany, approximately 40% of the turnover and the activities of German companies are of German companies. This is only performed as projects. This is only going to increase.**


The value of economic activity worldwide that is project oriented vill grow from \$12 trillion (in 2013) \$20 trillion (forecast 2027).*



- Too much focus on changing you sacrifice today in the hope of a better future

Implications of the Project Revolution

- 1. Silo mentality, internal competition
- 2. Working on what is urgent and short term (fire-fighting)
- 3. Strategic goals and priorities not clear, not understood
- 4. Lack of focus, spreading too thin
- 5. Too many projects, easy to start, never finish
- 6. Resource planning complex and ignored
- 7. PPM tool, very expensive, yet limited use
- 8. Lack of engagement, hard to retaining talent (and millennials)
